

This leaflet shows the walking route that has been checked and timed by our pupils.

In order to reduce congestion at the school gate we recommend that people who drive to school park at the free car park at the Southill shops and walk the rest of the way to school.



This will improve safety and the environment around the school site for everyone and allow the opportunity for some healthy exercise at the start and end of the school day.

Thank you for supporting our park and stride scheme.

Pupils from the school mapped and walked the route and found it takes between just 4 and 5 minutes to walk to or from school.

If you live closer to school than the car park you could walk or cycle to and from school every day. Even if you need the car to travel to work, it may be quicker and easier to leave it parked at home while you walk to school.

If you live near the car park, try walking or cycling. It could be quicker than you think!

If you have to travel by car to school, please park at the free car park and walk the rest of the way.
