Jumpers

A branded fleece jacket is also available.

Shoes

Shoes should be: black and sturdy (to offer protection when children are at play). Boots are fine in the

winter months – they should be black, as plain as possible, and of a sensible style, please.

Any sports branded or canvas type shoes are NOT part of our uniform.

Also not welcome:

- open-toed sandals
- trainers
- high heels

Why bother with a uniform?

We love our Southill School uniform. We think it's important to wear a clean, neat and tidy uniform for many reasons:

- to create a feeling of pride in children's appearance and themselves
- to provide a sense of togetherness and teamwork
- to reduce distraction away from learning
- to create a sense of order and purpose in the school
- to reduce peer pressure about the clothes children might otherwise wear.

Most parents try hard to support our uniform policy and so it is not fair on the majority if individual children wear anything different. Please support each other by sticking to the guidelines.
