



School Uniform

We're very proud of our children and want them to take pride in themselves as well. A smart school uniform is an important way to do this and so we expect children to wear clothing only from the options listed here.

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy.

Jumpers

The uniform is a branded jumper - not a plain jumper. They are available from our uniform suppliers (see bottom of sheet). Jumpers are available as a sweatshirt or a cardigan.

A branded fleece jacket is also available.

Please label all clothing



Shirt

White polo (plain/branded) or white cotton



Trousers and shorts

Grey or black (no jeans!)

Socks

Grey, black or white

Tights

Grey or black

Dress

Blue gingham summer dress

Grey/black pinafore dress or skirt

Skorts are fine if grey or black and of a sensible length



Shoes

Shoes should be: black and sturdy (to offer protection when children are at play).

Boots are fine in the winter months – they should be black, as plain as possible, and of a sensible style, please.



Any sports branded or canvas type shoes are NOT part of our uniform.



Also not welcome:

- open-toed sandals
- trainers
- high heels



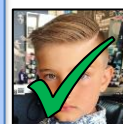
Why bother with a uniform?
