Wed, 28th October – Halloween Bingo

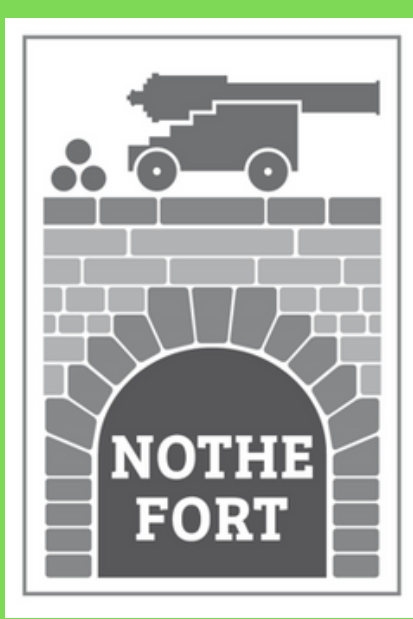

## COVID-19 SAFETY INFORMATION

With the safety measures we have in place, you can be sure that Nothe Fort is a Covid-Safe environment for events.

1. We have a one-way system around the fort.
2. We have cleaners going around the fort during the day.
3. Toilets are deep cleaned at regular intervals.
4. We have hand-sanitiser stations around the fort.
5. We have a controlled, outdoor space in which to hold events.
6. Face masks are required in all indoor areas of the fort.
7. We limit the number of attendees permitted to each event and monitor numbers on the day.
8. We have stewards around the fort to guide you through the one way system and politely remind visitors to social distance.
9. We have a Covid-Safety Commander on duty each day to monitor and review our safety measures.
