### Prime Areas:

Show sensitivity to others' needs and feelings. Talk confidently about ideas, home and community.

Use language to recreate roles and experiences in play situations.

Express themselves effectively, showing awareness of others.

Show good control and coordination in large and small movements.

Understand what contributes to good health.

### Expressive arts and Design/Understanding the World:

Know about similarities and differences around us.

Talk about features of our environment – observe animals and plants and explain why some things happen.

Explore ideas through art, music, dance, small world, role-play and stories.

### Literacy and Maths:

Read and understand simple sentences and talk about what they have read.

Use words and language influenced by experiences of books.

Use phonic knowledge to write words that match spoken sound.

Write own name, labels, captions and simple sentences.

Count with and explore numbers to 20.

Explore mathematical problems based on interests and experiences.
