After kidnapping one however, Artemis is about to discover fairies do not appreciate being captured and have some extremely powerful friends!

As scientists we will be making observations which involve looking closely at materials and their properties. We'll be comparing and grouping them, as well as identifying similarities, differences and changes. We will explore the three states of matter and see how we can interchange them, planning and carrying out our own investigations.

It's time to suspend our disbelief and open our minds. We're going on a magical journey to Alchemy Island! Can we find the gold hidden deep within the island's mysterious landscape? The only way is to study the map, unravel the riddle and begin our adventure. On the way, we must do all we can to learn about gold and master the ancient art of alchemy. We will be creative and try to impress the island's team of ace alchemists! Will they praise our scientific expertise? Could we compose a stunning soundtrack to bring this mysterious landscape to life? We've got our map, coordinates and everything else we need to make our way across Alchemy Island. Don't forget to pack our imaginations! Let the journey begin...
