



Year Three: Spring Term (2) 2022

Through The Ages

As mathematicians, the children will be learning about:

- Money .. adding & subtracting, using number bonds of 100. Problem solving
- Time ... telling the time to the minute, introduction to digital clocks, comparing times
- Graph making and interpreting.

As writers, the children will be studying a shortened version of the play 'Macbeth' – focusing on the writer's tools that build a setting.

As readers we'll enjoy a wild, big-hearted adventure as Charlie and the Stone Age boy set out together to find what they have lost - their courage, their hope, their family and their way home.

As musicians the children will be learning songs linked to the story of Macbeth

This project teaches children about British prehistory from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, including changes to people and lifestyle caused by ingenuity, invention and technological advancement.

As historians, children will learn the chronology of the Stone, Bronze and Iron ages – exploring changes in settlements, tools, weapons, jobs. We will also look at beliefs and monuments of the time
