## Southill Primary School: Reception Class Autumn (1) 2022



At the start of our school journey we support children to settle into the new routines of school, encouraging new friendships and developing confidence. We will learn about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and in school. Children will also find out how they are unique and special, learn about the importance of friendship and how people in their family, school and local community are important and can help them. Read some individual letters by saying the sound for them.

Anticipate some key events in stories.

Retell stories and narratives using own words and new vocabulary.

Begin to make marks and write some familiar letter sounds.
